Why donate by standing order?

All donations are gratefully received.

However it is much easier to budget if the monthly cash flow is regular and predictable. Standing order improves this regularity and predictability.

What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is a scheme operated by HM Revenue and Customs whereby a charitable body can reclaim the income tax paid on a donation provided, of course that the donor has paid income tax.

What difference does Gift Aid make?

On a taxable income of £100, you pay £20 income tax (basic rate is 20%) and receive £80. The charitable body can reclaim that £20 if it given the authority, that increases the value of an £80 gift by 25%. So a subscription of (say) £2 per month (£24 per year) will, through Gift increase the value of the gift by £6.

If I wish to subscribe, what do I need to do?

Please complete the standing order form and send it to the Treasurer, Epworth Old Rectory, 1 Rectory Street, Epworth, DN9 1HX . The only details that will be recorded and retained are your name and the amount of your subscription, then the form will be forwarded to your Bank at the address you give.

How do I make my gift eligible for Gift Aid?

Please complete the Gift Aid Declaration and send it to the Treasurer, Epworth Old Rectory, 1 Rectory Street, Epworth, DN9 1HX . Epworth Old Rectory will reclaim the Gift Aid each year.

Please note: If you do not pay income tax, do not complete the Gift Aid declaration. We also advise that you satisfy yourself that your total giving under the Gift Aid scheme does not exceed your taxable income.
